

2022 3-CUSHION CHALLENGE CUP

Concept

Invitational tournament promoted by Kozoom Group and sanctioned by the CEB:

- 24 players = 8 qualification groups + 1 final stage
- 16 days of competition with High quality production from March to October 2022
- Qualification groups = match between 3 players 18 sets to 10 Points (6 sets per day)
- Final stage = 8 players Double KO Head to Head matches Best of 7 sets to 10 points

- Total set won will decide the winner who will qualify to Final tournament
- In case of draw between three (6-6-6) or two players (4-7-7 or 2-8-8), a last decisive set will be played between three or two players

- Every player will choose his cueball according to the result of the lag
- Each player will keep the same cueball (white, yellow or orange) till the end of the match
- Break shot and order of play: player A (white), player B (yellow) and player C (orange):


Sets 1, 7, 13	A-B-C
Sets 2, 8, 14	B-A-C
Sets 3, 9, 15	C-A-B
Sets 4, 10, 16	A-C-B
Sets 5, 11, 17	B-C-A
Sets 6, 12, 18	C-B-A

- The ball of the third player in the set will be set on the red ball spot for every break shot
- Total set won (+ general average if needed) will rank the players qualified for the final stage.

Final stage

The final stage will be played from the in Double KO System as described here:

• The final tournament will be played in Head to Head matches: 10 points sets - Best of 7 sets

- 40 secondes shot clock / 1 extension per set
- 5 minutes break every 2 sets

Dress Code

Players are expected to be dressed in a clean, modern and classy look based on these rules:

- Required: polo and belt (Polo must be kept inside pant during the whole matches)
- <u>Not allowed:</u> Jeans, long or short-sleeved shirt, bow-tie, billiard waistcoat, red polo and green color on clothings or sponsors/country badges

Badges and logos of sponsors must be set according to CEB regulation:

- One advertisement up to 40 cm² in the lower half of the left chest side (it is not recommended to advertise on the side on which the national badge is worn)
- Up to 80 cm2 on the right chest side.
- Up to 80 cm2 on the right upper arm.
